





THE PEOPLE BEHIND FARM STAYS

LA GASSELINAIS

BED & BREAKFAST AND EDUCATIONAL FARM



For nearly 30 years, Catherine and her husband Florent have offered people the chance to live in harmony with the animals on their organic farm in Mayenne. It's an opportunity to taste their homemade cheeses and apple juice, learn more about how farms work and explore the surrounding countryside.



Keen to share their love of nature, in addition to stays on the farm, Catherine and Florent organise day trips that give school children aged 3-10 the chance to learn how to make apple juice, enjoy a zero-waste picnic and deepen their understanding of farm animals!

PDLL: Where did it all start?

This was my parents' farm. It's small and near the forest and river, so when we took it over in 1990, we thought it would make a great bed & breakfast. Eight years later, we decided to expand the farm and earn our living from it. We both used to work in teaching, so naturally we decided to do something educational with it, and that's why the farm is what it is today.

PDLL: What's different about you?

All our produce is organic and our water is heated by solar power. We do everything possible to make sure our visitors feel completely at home. Some people come back again and again, because their children really take to the farm - they treat it like their own. They get to meet other visitors who share the same interests.

PDLL: Who is it for?

We get all sorts of visitors, from townies in search of a rural retreat, to people who love exploring and want something a bit different - a holiday with a twist. From March to July, we also invite schools and groups of children, who come and meet the animals and explore life on a farm.







ÉCOLE FRANÇAISE DE VOILE (EFV) CERTIFIED SAILING CENTRE



Bruno began working as a sailing instructor at the age of 18. Here he tells us about his long-time employer, non-profit organisation Nautisme en Pays Blanc. This EFV-certified sailing centre has branches in Quimac, Piriac and La Turballe, in Loire-Atlantique, and runs a wide range of fun sailing activities.



A member of Vogue & Vague, a scheme that promotes watersports for all, Nautisme en Pays Blanc organises year-round sailing activities to enjoy with family or friends. To help you get the most out of sailing, it runs introductory courses, hires out kayaks, stand-up paddleboards and catamarans, and organises schooner trips around Dumet island.

PDLL: Where did it all start?

This non-profit organisation was set up in 1983 by social groups and the district of Piriac to help more people learn how to sail and to promote local sailing activities. Three other districts - La Turballe, St Molf and Mesquer - soon joined the scheme. It is now one of the biggest sailing schools in France and manages three watersports centres, in Quimiac, Piriac and La Turballe.

PDLL: What's different about you?

We now organise sailing trips and activities like kayaking, paddleboarding and canoeing to offer families a wider choice of activities. We also run training courses and multi-paddle excursions so visitors can try each of these three watersports.

In 2020, we plan to offer activities that are more relaxing, to improve people's wellbeing. We are also trained and equipped to assist people with disabilities.

PDLL: Who is it for?


Outside the school holidays, we mainly cater for school groups and young people from the local area. During the holidays, we offer a broader range of activities, including large numbers of tourists from beginners to more experienced people, who want to have fun on the water.



PDLL: Where did it all start?

After studying wine and business, I visited a lot of different vineyards in France and Latin America. I realised there was a lot of interest in wine tourism both here and abroad, so when I got back to Vendée I decided to plant my own vineyard near Les Sables-d'Olonne, which is already popular with tourists.

PDLL: What's different about you?

Throughout the year, we organise tours of our vineyards and wine storehouse, followed by tastings of our various wines. We explain the role soil plays in organic and biodynamic vine-

growing and recently began organising treasure hunts in our vineyards. We've also teamed up with a local restaurant to serve top-quality meals on the estate.

PDLL: Who is it for?

Most of our visitors are couples, families or corporate clients. We want everyone to be able to enjoy wine tourism, which is why we make a point of organising events on the estate throughout the year.






ORIGINAL VÉLO TOUR

CYCLE RIDES THROUGH THE MARSHLANDS IN THE POITOU AREA



DAMIEN MOULIN

The Poitevin marshland and the southern Vendée are more complex and extensive than meets the eye. Set up in 2017, the Original Vélo Tour® takes cyclists off the beaten track to show them more about these remarkable sites and chat to passionate local producers about their fascinating work.



PDLL: Where did it all start?

I studied for a degree in events management and then did seasonal work on the coast. In 2011, I was the first to organise guided tours of Ile de Ré for cyclists. When I hit my thirties, I decided to settle down and set up my own business. Cycle tourism sprang to mind, and after thinking about it for a while, I came up with the idea of guided food tours. Little by little, word got round and I started to earn a reputation as a tour guide – and then I became the local go-to guy!

PDLL: What's different about you?

I put people first. From the moment visitors get

in touch with me, I aim to give them the right advice and organise a ride that speaks to them and their interests. Then, during the tour, I take them to meet producers who I select for their ability to clearly explain their work and convey their passion.

PDLL: Who is it for?

I organise tours for groups and companies, as well as families with children, and couples. I tailor every tour to the people I show around.

CYCLING TRIPS & HOLIDAYS

The Atlantic Loire Valley region is traversed by three of France's main cycle routes – the Vélodyssée, Loire à Vélo and Vélo Francette – making it an ideal holiday destination for cyclists. From the north of

THE SAINT-BRÉVIN-LES-PINS CROSSROADS



Situated on the south bank of the Loire estuary opposite Saint-Nazaire, Saint-Brévin-les-Pins stands at the crossroads of two of Europe's major cycle routes: La Loire à Vélo (EV6) and La Vélodyssée (EV1). The aim is to get more people involved by organising a sporting challenge and a fun event where cycling meets nature.



This national cycle route connecting La Véloscénie to La Loire à Vélo is ideal for history buffs. Taking cyclists from the Alpes Mancelles to the Château of Saumur, Le Mans with its celebrated Cité Plantagenêt, and the twisting steeples of Baugeois in Haut-Anjou, this peaceful route sheds light on the region's architectural heritage and its rich and varied landscape.




