


Read below our four reasons for exploring the Loire Valley wine trails, and get the most out of this big region full of surprises!

1. Have some great days out exploring different winegrowing areas

By bike, on foot, by car, canoe or even in a traditional riverboat known as a gabare, there are many ways to explore the Pays de la Loire! Whether you prefer a day trip or a break lasting several days, the different itineraries available offer you an opportunity to explore the vineyards at your own pace.

2. Encounter some beautiful landscapes and unmissable activities along the way!

The Routes des Vins are not just wine trails. Stop off along the way to explore the city of Nantes, admire the sunset from the Château of Saumur, be awestruck by the cave dwelling village of Rochemenier, or feel the sand between your toes on the beaches of the Atlantic coast.

Muscadet, Saumur, Jasnières, Coteaux-du-Loir, Anjou... The wines on the wine trails are lively, fresh and elegant. 

Clisson



A journey through the Nantes vineyard





ROUTE 1 2 DAYS - 110 KM Departure from Nantes On the Wine Routes, this circuit will take you through vineyards, rivers and medieval sites... Venture into the grape varieties of Melon de Bourgogne or Folle Blanche, to taste Muscadet, the area's flagship wine. Nantes gives the points of departure and arrival of this loop.

For 2 days, head south to admire bucolic landscapes, between the banks of Sèvre Nantaise and vineyards. In Vertou, the Chaussée des Moines invites to a stroll along the River Sèvre. Visit Clisson, a medieval town that will take you on a journey to Tuscany... At Butte de la Roche, further North, you can admire a beautiful panorama over the vineyards, marshes and Château de Goulaine.

Welcome to the wine estate **Poiron Dabin** in Château-Thébaud for a visit and wine tasting.

Invitation to wine estate Château du Coing in Saint-Fiacre-sur-Maine to visit vineyards, wine cellars and taste a range of Muscadets.

Day 2/Morning



Guided tour of Clisson to discover the fascinating history of the city, the impressive medieval castle, narrow streets and along the banks of the Sèvre Nantaise a range of Tuscan colors.



Visit and wine tasting at **Château** Cassemichère in La Chapelle Heulin, built in 1601.

Alternative: Segway stroll in the middle of the vines of Château du Cleray, Vallet



Lunch at Hall Saint-Lazare in Le Loroux Bottereau, a gastropub in a former town hall, which has opted for discretion and finesse.











Day 2/Afternoon



La Roche hill belvedere (Le Loroux-Bottereau): at the top of its 47 meters, in the heart of the vineyard you will enjoy a superb panorama view over the marshes of Goulaine and Nantes.



Visit of the Goulaine castle in Haute-Goulaine, a beautiful Renaissance castle on the banks of the Loire, today the showcase and official museum of the LU biscuit collection.



Exceptional dinner at Manoir de la Boulaie in Haute-Goulaine, a two-Michelin-starred restaurant. The dishes pull into a whirlwind of emotions, magnified by beautiful setting of this "folie nantaise" (a typical local manor house).

Alternatives : Villa Mon Rêve, Basse Goulaine or Restaurant Clémence, St-Julien-de-Concelles



Night at Seven Urban Suites in Nantes, it offers the feeling of being at home right in the heart of Nantes.

ROUTE 2 2 DAYS - 110 KM Departure from Nantes

Loire, nothing but Loire!

Exploring this wine route, you will really feel the river Loire and its fabulous heritage. Every single stage has a direct link with the Royal river.

You will visit wine estates with an astonishing panorama view over the river, have lunch on a terrace with a river view, discover the fabulous Oudon Tower which once guarded the river border or enjoy a peaceful cruise on the river....



Wine tasting at wine estate **Domaine** des Génaudières in Le Cellier, with a breathtaking view over the Loire.







Visit of **Oudon's medieval castle** to discover the river Loire across centuries through audiovisual display. On the rooftop, one of the most beautiful views over the river!

Alternative: Ancenis local market on Thursday and







Lunch at La Table du Pêcheur in Ancenis, with a waterfront terrace. Fresh fish specialities, seafood platter and Loire

Visit of St-Florent-le-Vieil, a city of character! Its abbey-church marks the Loire landscape. A tour of the old town or a walk along the Julien Gracq promenade on the Loire banks will reveal its beauty and charm.





Dinner at restaurant La Gabelle in Saint-Florent-le-Vieil, its panoramic view over the Loire offers a spectacular sunset when night falls. It perpetuates the region's gourmet tradition and offers dishes prepared with flavoursome, locally-sourced produce.

Visit and wine tasting at **Domaine des Galloires** in Drain, with an exceptional view on the Loire. Here, Malvoisie, an aromatic white wine produced from Pinot Gris grapes, is an institution.









Lunch at restaurant La Citadelle in Champtoceaux. Old stone and wooden beams atmosphere, it offers traditional dishes of French cuisine.

Alternative : Brasserie **La Cohue** in Champtoceaux



Day 2/Afternoon



Cruise on the Loire with La Luce. The tour introduces passengers to the river's wildlife, and also to the buildings along its banks. Along the way, passengers can enjoy some magnificent views, including fishing villages and a monumental garden built on a rocky outcrop.





Dinner at **Restaurant Clémence**, a gourmet restaurant on the banks of the Loire in Saint-Julien-de-Concelles. Regional and creative cuisine using fresh local products. The spirit of Clémence, mother of the famous "beurre blanc" sauce, still reigns over the restaurant.






Night at **Residhome Les Berges de la** Loire**** in Nantes, located in the heart of the new Euronantes district, on the banks of the Loire. The aparthotel enjoys a great location that allows you to easily walk to the city center and to the train station.

ROUTE 3 2 DAYS - 90 KM Departure from Angers The Coteaux du Layon hills and castles wine route starts in Angers, where you can visit the city, the castle and its famous medieval Tapestry, and last but not least the Anjou-Saumur Wine House. Along this itinerary, pretty villages follow one another: Savennières, Béhuard or La Possonnière...

This trail is also an opportunity to discover local restaurants and taste the Anjou chicken, with a glass of Savennières. After that, stop at Rablay-sur-Layon to admire the work of craftsmen, or take the time to visit the highest castle in France: the Château de Brissac, still home to the Brissac Family.



After a stroll in Savennieres, a "little city of character", enjoy a wine tasting session at **Domaine du Closel**. Discover famous dry white, red, rosé and sparkling wines and feel under your feet the slopes of slate hillsides warmed by the sun of Anjou.



Discover Béhuard, an island village that is a delight to explore! This little village is also a pilgrimage site.





Lunch at **La Corniche**, in St-Aubin-de-Luigné. The restaurant proposes a marketcuisine made with fresh local produces.

Alternative: La Croisette, open from May to September, Béhuard

Dinner at La Table de la Bergerie (1 Michelin Star) in Champ-sur-Layon. The cuisine is refined, authentic and contemporary. The menu changes with the seasons and gives pride of place to the work of local producers. The estate is located in the heart of the Coteaux du Layon wine region.



Night at the **Domaine de la Soucherie**, in Rochefort-surLoire. Beautiful views of the vineyards in each guest room.

Roger and Pascale Beguinot designed this house to make it an ideal place to rest and relax.

Alternative : **Château de l'Epinay**, Saint-Georges-sur-Loire





Day 2/Morning



Discover charming winegrowers' villages on the wine route: Aubigné-sur-Layon, Rablay-sur-Layon and Thouarcé.





Wine tasting at the wine estate **Château de Fesles** in Thouarcé. The winegrowers will be delighted to let you explore the vineyards around the property and the splendid barrel cellar where their prestigious cuvées are aged.



Lunch at **Les terrasses de Bonnezeaux** in Thouarcé, a gourmet bistro serving traditional cuisine in the middle of the vineyards.







Day 2/Afternoon



Visit the **Château de Brissac**: the tallest Castle in France. With its 7 floors and 204 rooms, Brissac deserves its nickname of "Giant of the Loire Valley".





Discover the Loire Valley wines diversity in the **Caves de la Loire**, in Brissac Loire Aubance.





Dinner at Les 3 lieux in Les-Ponts-de-cé, with a fabulous view on the Loire, either inside or on the terrace. The Chef and his team prepare traditional meals with fresh seasonal produce for all kinds of appetites, big or small.




Night at Les 3 lieux, tucked away on the banks of the Loire, this former fishing hook factory, steeped in local heritage, has been transformed into a unique friendly and intrepid venue incorporating a Hotel, a Restaurant and a Bistro.

2 DAYS - 90 KM
Departure
from Saumur

Around Saumur, you'll discover a new world of underground life and the famous "troglodyte" cave dwellings dug in tufa stone. But also astonishing architecture, castles, a royal abbey, monumental cellars, mills and the rich landscapes of the UNESCO Loire Valley. Your route will be marked out with wineries and vineyards. Stop and meet the local winemakers who'll share their pasison with enthusiasm. You will taste the wines produced on these soils: Saumur-Champigny or Saumur Rouge with aromas of wild fruits, Coteaux de Saumur or Coteaux du Layon with golden reflections, the festive sparkling Saumur Brut or Crémant de Loire, gourmet Saumur Rosé or Cabernet d'Anjou... and so many others... The vineyards and the universe of the incredible underground world of Saumur are waiting for you. Have a great time!



Visit the Chateau de Saumur, the castle of Dukes of Anjou. It stands at the edge of an abrupt cliff and boasts prime views of the city and the Loire Valley.





Visit the renowned **Ackerman** cellars - the pioneer of Loire Valley fine sparkling wines. Uncover the secrets of the méthode traditionnelle. Plunge into the heart of unique and monumental tuffa stone cellars. Travel through monumental exhibitions of passionate artists.

Alternative: Cycling visit and wine tasting at famous **Bouvet-Ladubay** cellars in Saumur.







Lunch at La Table des Fouées in Saumur. Taste local specialties inside an amazing troglodyte cave.

Alternative: Lunch with a majestic view over the Loire River at **Le Castellane**, Chenehuttes-Treves-Cunault



ROUTE 4

Day 2/Morning



Visit the Château de Brezé. Considered as one of the most intriguing castles of the Loire, partly due to its underground fortress. Discovering the castle's history will allow to understand the bond some of the Kings of France had with it.

Alternative: The extraordinary medieval fortress Chateau of Montreuil-Bellay

Day 1/ Afternoon



The cave dwelling village museum of Rochemenier invites to discover an underground world: two ancient troglodytic farms with their rooms and dependencies. A unique underground lifestyle in the Loire valley!



Wine tasting at the wine estate Domaine de la Paleine, in Le-Puy-Notre-Dame. Production of more than 100,000 bottles in red, white. rosé or sparkling organic wines.







Dinner at L'auberge Bienvenue in Doué la Fontaine. Reputed as one of the best tables in the region, the Auberge Bienvenue proposes regional dishes with fresh produce from local markets and producers.





Night at L'auberge Bienvenue*** Quality and comfort amenities... Large bright extremely comfortable rooms. Each room has been individually thought out and well decorated with pleasant soft tones.

Alternative: Chai de la Paleine, Le-Puy-Notre-Dame



Day 2/Afternoon



Visit Turquant, a very pleasant small village that is literally built into the hillside of tufa stone.





Welcome to the royal abbey of **Fontevraud**, the largest abbey in Europe. It is one of the unmissable stops on a visit to the Loire Valley. A stop, but also a destination.. an essentially unique site!







Dinner at **Le Plantagenet** in Fontevraud. Contemporary and bistro cuisine combined with classic French dishes served in a refurbished restaurant.

Alternative: Exceptionnal dinner at Fontevraud Le Restaurant (1 Michelin star)





A stay at the heart of Fontevraud Royal Abbey? Fontevraud L'Hôtel offers an incomparable experience. Sleeping in the tranguil silence of the Abbey, walking alone through the monastery as night falls... these are magical private moments.

Alternative : A night at Hostellerie de la Croix Blanche*** facing the abbey

ROUTE 5 1 DAY - 25 KM Departure from La Chartresur-le-Loir

La Chartre-sur-le-Loir is home to many craftsmen: ceramists, antique dealers, glassmakers... Take time to closely observe their meticulous work and to exchange with passionate people. From La Chartre-sur-le-Loir to Ruillé-sur-Loir, on your bike, follow the small paths winding through the Chenin vineyards. To cool off, stop and enjoy a glass of Jasnières, a dry and fruity white wine, renowned as one of the best dry white wines in France. From there, continue your ride down to Poncé-sur-le-Loir and visit the castle and its Italian garden. E-bikes are recommended on this route if you'd like to enjoy the wonderful overviews from the top of the hills!

ROUTE 6 1 DAY - 31 KM Departure from Bremsur-Mer The first step of this circuit is the charming village of Brem-sur-Mer, on the Vendée Atlantic coast, with its listed Saint-Nicolas Church.

From there, drive to the old fishing village La Gachère. What a better place to taste the local oysters, accompanied by a glass or two of Fiefs vendéens white wine. In the summer, don't forget your swimsuit to enjoy the waves of the Atlantic Ocean on the sandy beaches of Bretignolles sur mer. Sea, wine and sun are on the agenda!

Stroll around Brem-sur-Mer to discover the charming village and its listed Saint-Nicolas Church. Continue to the old fishing village of "La Gachère" and taste oysters with white wine. Enjoy Vendée treasures!



On Thursday and Sunday, visit the delightful market in Bretignolles-sur-Mer: fresh fruit and vegetables from local producers, fish and seafood... A unique gourmet experience!
