For a glimpse of other worlds, simply open your eyes, admire the view and let your imagination go with the flow...





#### **Admire**

#### the Maine Valley from the Château-Thébaud lookout point (44)

For breathtaking wraparound views over the Maine Valley and its granite cliffs carpeted with vineyards, head for the Château-Thébaud lookout on Pont Caffino, a clifftop 45 metres above the river. Designed by Savoyard architect Emmanuel Ritz, this 30-metre-long viewing gallery is one of the permanent sites on the Voyage à Nantes (Journey to Nantes) culture and heritage trail. Take time out as you watch the sun set over the vineyards of Nantes.

#### **Enjoy**

#### a unique vantage point over the Loire Valley from the Mont-Glonne esplanade (49)

A must for visitors to Saint-Florent-le-Vieil, the Mont-Glonne esplanade affords stunning views of the Loire Valley. Halfway between Nantes and Angers, these fortifications steeped in history enjoy commanding vistas over the former fishing village of La Meilleraie and Palais Briau, a 19th-century palace of Italian inspiration built in the pure Palladian style.

#### the sun set from the Pêcheries de Corsept (44)

For postcard-perfect views, there's nothing like watching the sun set over the Loire estuary and its traditional stilted seaside fishing huts to set your mind free just minutes from Saint-Nazaire. For visitors in search of peace and quiet, the Corsept seawall to the south of the Loire is an ideal spot to enjoy a moment of uninterrupted bliss as you dream of new horizons...





#### Discover

### an underground world in Souzay-Champigny (72)

One of the most prestigious wine-growing areas in the Saumur region, Souzay-Champigny is famed for its unique troglodyte architecture, unusual landscapes and Saumur-Champigny wine production. Located on the Loire, this one-of-a-kind village bears witness to tuffeau and shell marl stone quarrying in Anjou during the medieval period. The natural cavities created by quarrying were gradually occupied by local people who transformed them into dwellings and then into mushroom and wine cellars. Between the houses built from local tuffeau stone, explore the subterranean streets cut into cliffs lined with beautiful manor houses.

### **back in time**in Sainte-Suzanne (53)


At the heart of the Mayenne bocage, the medieval settlement of Sainte-Suzanne is considered one of the most beautiful villages in France. Perched on a rocky spur above the Erve Valley, this historic village enjoys many stunning views over the surrounding countryside. Its lovingly preserved architectural heritage, stone houses and narrow flower-lined streets untouched by the hands of time make the perfect bucolic interlude.

### Reach new heights in the Toyères canyon (72)

On the border between La Sarthe and La Mayenne, in the rural district of Saint-Pierre-des-Nids, this extraordinary landscape has been carved from granite rock by the winding course of the Sarthe river. A picturesque site set deep in the Mancelles Alps, the Toyères canyon viewing platform overlooks the Sarthe river gorges for breathtaking panoramas. Renowned for its preserved natural environment, this unique and authentic site commands bird's-eye views over a leafy landscape.

### on the rocky coast of the Île d'Yeu (85)

A sparkling island on the Atlantic coast, the Île d'Yeu, with its varied landscape and rich, preserved natural environment, makes the perfect getaway. From the Pointe du But to the Pointe de Corbeaux, the small creeks and rocky cliffs along the island's west coast recall the Celtic seascapes of Brittany and Ireland. There are few better examples than the beaches of Sables Rouis and Belle Maison, nestled between the craggy cliffs and wild moors near the Old Castle.

# Explore at your own pace

If you enjoy exploring destinations at your own pace, getting closer to nature and connecting with local communities in sustainable ways, there's nothing like a free-roaming holiday on eco-friendly transport. For anyone who prefers the road less travelled, there are countless laidback ways to explore the Atlantic Loire Valley region by foot, bicycle, train or boat. For an original and out-of-the-ordinary experience, hire an electric scooter or segway.





### A connected and intermodal public transport network

To promote the use of public, eco-friendly and intermodal forms of transport, since 2017, the Atlantic Loire Valley region has been working to expand and improve its regional train network and make it more accessible. The Loire à Vélo train, for example, welcomes bicycles free of charge between Orléans and Le Croisic. As the mood takes them, cycle tourists following the Loire à Vélo route can also continue their journey by water on a boat cruise along the Loire.

#### Explore 3,000 km of cycle routes


The Atlantic Loire Valley is crossed by several major cycling routes recognised for their quality facilities and easy access, including La Vélobuissonnière, La Vélodyssée, La Loire à Vélo, La Vélo Francette, La Vélocéan, and the La Vallée du Loir à Vélo. Cycle tourists can choose from more than 3,000 kilometres of cycle routes. Since cyclists can travel at their own pace and get closer to nature, it's an unbeatable way to explore the beauty and diversity of the Loire region. Thanks to more than 640 professionals awarded the Accueil Vélo label providing quality, cycle-friendly services across the region, everyone can enjoy cycle tourism in the Atlantic Loire Valley, including families and beginners.




#### Water sports

#### The Rivières de l'Ouest®: 283 km of navigable **riverways** (53-72-49)

France's largest network of navigable rivers and its second most popular river destination, the Rivières de l'Ouest offers 283 kilometres of navigable waterways spread over four rivers straddling three regions - Anjou, La Mayenne and La Sarthe to delve into the Atlantic Loire Valley by water. For a bucolic stay on the river, simply go with the flow by renting a houseboat for one or more days. It's an ideal way to admire the lock houses, attractive villages and waterside bars and cafés that line the banks of the Loire.





#### **Cvcle Tourism**

#### An open-air museum along the Loire à Vélo trail from **Nantes to Saint-Nazaire** (44)

From Nantes to Saint-Nazaire, the Loire à Vélo cycle route runs along the Loire estuary for 63 kilometres. Spend a day or weekend admiring the collection of contemporary artworks along the Estuary route, with the option of returning by train at the end of your trip. From the Pendule by Roman Signer in the pretty village of Trentemoult to the incredible Serpent d'Océan by Huang Yong Ping on Saint-Brévin-les-Pins beach and the beautiful Jardin étoilé with views over the Loire by Kinya Maruyama in Paimboeuf, this family-friendly trail combines fresh air fun with art. Perfect for a complete change of scene not far from Nantes.


#### Original accommodation

#### A romantic night on the Loire on board the Étoile qui Rit (49)

Departing from Montsoreau, l'Étoile qui Rit - a flatbottomed wooden boat identical to a traditional "toue" craft with a large deck cabin - runs themed cruises along the Loire for tourists to discover the many species of birds and historical sights on the peaceful banks of this royal river. Besides terns, grey herons and little egrets, visitors can also admire two châteaux - Montsoreau and Saumur - from the water. Leave the world behind as you go with the flow before watching the sun set or enjoying a romantic night on the Loire.

Excursions from €125 an hour for 1 to 12 people. One night from €150 for 2 people.





#### Water sports and cycle tourism

### **La Mayenne by bicycle and boat with Canotika** (53)

Starting from Château-Gontier, a few kilometres south of Laval, hire a Dandy boat from Canotika from April to October. Suitable for people of all ages, these small crafts are easy to steer and extremely stable for trips along the Mayenne at your own pace. Canotika also hires out electric bicycles and mountain bikes so you can continue exploring La Vélo Francette cycle route along the towpath.

Dandy boat hire from €8 for 15 minutes. Bicycle hire from €7.60.

#### Explore the vineyards of the Domaine Saint-Nicolas by scooter (85)

Surrounded by marshland and forests, the Saint-Nicolas family estate between L'Île d'Olonne and Brem-sur-Mer organises tours of its vineyards by electric scooter. Follow this original excursion into the natural and cultural heritage of the Pays des Olonnes by a guided tour of the wine press and storehouse and sample the estate's five premium cuvée wines.



### Go with the flow in the Atlantic Loire Valley

There's nothing like a trip on the water to explore the Atlantic Loire Valley region from a completely different angle. Accompanied by a qualified guide, explore the Atlantic Loire Valley, its landscapes and heritage on a paddle board, canoe, sailboat or "toue sablière" - a traditional flatbottomed boat once used to collect sand from the riverbed - as you navigate the Loire, marshlands or Atlantic coast on a short excursion or longer trek with family or friends. Choose from no fewer than 31 experiences in La Baule. Noirmoutier. Le Mans and Nantes.

#### Cycle tourism and wine tourism

### **Bucolic bicycle trip through the Loir Valley** (72)

Explore vineyards, orchards, picturesque villages and troglodyte dwellings along the 320-kilometre Vallée du Loir à Vélo cycle route from Saint-Éman to Angers. Two new circuits starting from La Flèche were opened in July 2021. The first leads visitors around two iconic sites in the Loir Valley - the famous La Flèche zoo and the Château of Le Lude - along a 48-kilometre trail. The second takes in twisted steeples and marshland along 36 kilometres of a converted former trailway track. On the nearby Wine Route, starting from Chartre-sur-le-Loir or Ruillé-sur-Loir, the "Vignoble de Jasnières à vélo" wine discovery circuit guides cyclists along a 16-kilometre route through the vineyards of Chenin to learn more about this AOC white wine.



# Take a new approach to city breaks



Aware of the need to develop a new and environmentally sustainable economic model, many towns in the Atlantic Loire Valley region are greening their centres while improving quality of life for residents and visitors. Nantes, Angers and Cholet have won national recognition and awards for their long-standing commitment to the planet. Many urban areas in the Atlantic Loire Valley region are also fortunate to be crossed by rivers with adapted embankments and by major cycle routes.





#### Nantes:

### the city of 101 parks and gardens (44)


For visitors looking to relax in leafy surroundings, Nantes has more than 1,000 hectares of wild areas and gardens, including the Jardin des Plantes, the Jardin Extraordinaire and the Île de Versailles. Winner of the European Green Capital Award in 2013 and ranked France's second greenest city in 2020, it focuses its urban development projects around nature and aims to become a "Sustainable Innovative Destination" in 2022. Take time out and relax with nature as your companion on waterside walks through this city crossed by three rivers: the Loire, the Erdre and the Chézine. For the ultimate slow experience, visit Nantes and its environs by bicycle on one of two iconic cycle routes: La Loire à Vélo and the Nantes-Brest Canal.





#### Laval:

#### **green and blue city** (53)

Deep in the Mayenne region, Laval is ideal for tourists who love small towns with real charm where they can explore local heritage sites in a pristine natural setting. Crossed by the Mayenne, Laval has more than 259 hectares of green spaces and countless ways to explore the town and surrounding area while enjoying the fresh air. Why not discover Laval on a familyfriendly river cruise by electric boat? The nearby Echologia park - a disused lime quarry transformed as part of an environmental rehabilitation programme - is also ideal for a peaceful day out with the family, where water, ecology, local heritage and outdoor fun meet.

Hire electric boats without a licence from the Halte fluviale de Laval from €20 an hour for 4 to 5 people.





#### Le Mans:

### 500-hectare nature reserve just outside the city (72)

The Arche de la Nature is a vast 500-hectare nature reserve just ten minutes from the centre of Le Mans and a short walk from the Abbaye Royale de l'Épau. Bringing visitors back to nature, a learning trail explores the landscapes and animals in La Sarthe, its water houses, forests and grasslands. For a one-of-a-kind experience, visitors can extend their visit by spending a relaxing night in one of six eco-lodges on the Domaine de l'Épau, opened at the end of 2021. With green roofs, pellet heating and phyto-purification systems, these innovative low-energy lodges are built as part of an environmentally-friendly approach.



## In Noirmoutier The Müllembourg nature reserve: a paradise for birds (85)

At the heart of the Île de Noirmoutier and just minutes from Noirmoutier-en-l'Île, the Müllembourg nature reserve is a refuge for countless animal and plant species. This outstanding 48-hectare marshland site is ideal for observing - discreetly, of course - a wide variety of nesting birds in spring, including the common shelduck, the common tern, and the black-capped avocet, as well as the handful of salt collectors who still work here. It's unusual to find a nature reserve this big so close to town!




### Explore the towns of the Loire from the water

There's nothing like a guided tour of the region's iconic sites and their secrets to really get to grips with its history and local culture. From the Abbaye Royale de Fontevraud to the Château d'Angers, and the Solesme Abbey to the Château of Tiffauges and the residence of the dukes of Brittany, the Atlantic Loire Valley region enjoys an exceptional architectural and cultural heritage, witness to the region's rich history, but also smaller, under-the-radar sites like the Robert Tatin museum, the Château of Bourgon and the Château of Le Plessis Macé. This diversity means visitors can explore the region as they please.





#### **Explore art**

#### from every angle in Saint-Nazaire (44)

From modern, classic and contemporary artworks to street art and exhibitions in out-of-the-ordinary places, Saint-Nazaire is an open-air art gallery to explore on walks around the streets of this surprising city. Integrated into the cityscape, a myriad of outsized works can be found in every corner of town. Saint-Nazaire is also home to quirky social spaces like the Grand Café, the Centre d'Art Contemporain and the Life, a former German submarine base that regularly hosts eye-opening exhibitions.

#### Le Carrousel des Mondes Marins

#### is ten years old! (44)

A symbol of the city of Nantes, the famous Carrousel des Mondes Marins, like its neighbour the Grand Éléphant, celebrates its first decade in 2022. Located on the Île de Nantes next to the Loire, opposite the Jules Verne Museum, this incredible 25-metre-high structure created by La Machine theatre company explores the marine world over three floors, from the seabed through the deep ocean abyss and up to the surface. The hardest part is choosing your mount: a giant crab, the bathyscaphe, the manta ray or

#### The Apocalypse Tapestry:

#### the largest set of medieval tapestries in the world (49)

A masterwork of medieval pictorial art, the Apocalypse Tapestry, commissioned by Duke Louis I of Anjou, depicts the Apocalypse of Saint John spread over six tapestries, each divided into 14 scenes. Created during the Hundred Years' War, it bears terrible witness to the tumultuous events that haunted its creation and the historical, social and political conditions of the late 14th century. Some 100 of the original 140 metres of this unique work have been preserved and are now on show in their own museum at the Château d'Angers.

The Château d'Angers opens from 12 February. Daily from 10am to 5.30pm.

The Apocalypse Gallery closes 15 minutes before the château.

Free for children under -18.

#### The Château du Plessis Macé:

#### where history and culture meet (49)

Witness to the medieval splendour of Anjou and its eventful history, the Château of Le Plessis Macé now organises a packed programme of cultural events. Visitors are invited to explore this château built in the Flamboyant Gothic style, just 15 minutes from Angers, at their own pace or during family-friendly events and escape games. The site also plays host to countless events all year round, including the Anjou Festival and its open-air theatre programme and the European Heritage Days.


#### The Robert Tatin Museum:

#### a curious creation deep in the Mayenne bocage (53)

World renowned Mayenne artist, Robert Tatin created an extraordinary world that blurs the boundaries between nature and culture. An improbable palace approached along an alley lined with giants and other imaginary creatures, this unique work was inspired by his travels in South America. A wonderful opportunity to let your imagination run wild during a visit to Mayenne.

#### Solesmes Abbey:

#### a religious landmark in La Sarthe (72)

Halfway between Le Mans and Angers and close to Sablé-sur-Sarthe is one of the most remarkable religious buildings in France: the Solesmes Abbey. On the banks of the Sarthe river in a peaceful setting, this epicentre of Gregorian chant offers visitors a unique chance to attend a chanted service. Adorned with two remarkable sculptural ensembles, The Saints of Solesmes, the transept of the chapel is considered a masterpiece of French sculpture from late 15th and early 16th centuries

#### The Château de Bourgon:

#### a historical monument surrounded by nature (53)

Set in the leafy surroundings of Montourtier, at the heart of Mayenne, the Château of Bourgon, built in the 15th and 16th centuries, used to be an important stronghold during the English occupation of the region in the Hundred Years' War. A listed historic monument, this building with a Renaissance heritage hosts an array of cultural events throughout the year including concerts, exhibitions, theatre plays and open-air cinema screenings. Hire one of three recently opened cosy guestrooms with an authentic feel to extend your stay and spend the weekend in this outstanding natural environment.

The nearby gardens of the Château Colbert are home at a vast 8,000 sq.m. kitchen garden, voted the "Most Beautiful Vegetable Garden in France" in 2016 and 2021.
