This technical guide dedicated to wine tourism offers has been prepared just for you! We recommend 7 itineraries which can be easily combined with other tours you already know in the Loire Valley châteaux, to Normandy-Mont-Saint-Michel & Brittany or the Bordeaux area.



## This guide was prepared to introduce you into the richness of the Loire Valley and its wines and art de vivre.

For each of the 7 itineraries, we recommend visits and activities such as key heritage sites, wining and dining, magnificent scenery, and great places to stay.

They partly follow the Loire Valley Routes des Vins, winding their way from the Atlantic Coast to Saumur and its fine bubbles, via the Muscadet and Anjou vineyards and the more secret Jasnières and Coteaux du Loir appellations in the north. They will also take you a little further to the Great Châteaux region.

Whether you prefer a day trip or a break lasting several days, the different itineraries available offer you an opportunity to explore the vineyards at your own pace.

The Routes des Vins are not just wine trails. Stop off along the way to explore the city of Nantes, admire the sunset from the Château of Saumur, be awestruck by the cave dwelling village of Rochemenier, or feel the sand between your toes on the beaches of the Atlantic coast.

#### TASTE WORLD-CLASS AOC-LABELLED WINES AND LESSER-KNOWN GEMS

Muscadet, Saumur, Jasnières, Coteaux-du-Loir, Anjou... The wines on the wine trails are lively, fresh and elegant. In Atlantic Loire Valley, you will come across some world-famous AOC-labelled wines, and also several little appellations worth tasting! And the region is full of specialties that perfectly pair with our wines. Taste local specialties from the sea, like the Guérande or Noirmoutier salt, fresh fish or oysters. And don't miss local produce from the land, quality fruit and vegetables from the "Garden of France", or the tender chicken of Loué or Challans, the pork rillettes from Le Mans. And for those with a sweet tooth, there are the LU or Sablé biscuits, the rum cake "Gâteau nantais", not to forget Angers' Giffard and Cointreau liqueurs, perfect for cocktails.

#### **MEET LOCAL WINEGROWERS AND CRAFTSMEN**

In the Loire Valley, you will find not only *terroir*, but down-to-earth, genuine people who are passionate about their trades. 



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## A JOURNEY THROUGH THE NANTES VINEYARD

On the Wine Routes, this circuit will take you through vineyards, rivers and medieval sites... Venture into the grape varieties of Melon de Bourgogne or Folle Blanche, to taste Muscadet, the area's flagship wine. This itinerary is a round trip from Nantes.

For 2 days, head south to admire bucolic landscapes, between the banks of Sèvre Nantaise and vineyards. In Vertou, the Chaussée des Moines invites you to a stroll along the River Sèvre. Visit Clisson, a medieval town that will take you on a journey to Tuscany...

At Butte de la Roche, further north, you can admire a beautiful panorama over the vineyards, marshes and Château de Goulaine.



## Day 1











#### Morning

The **Chaussée des Moines** in Vertou invites you to a stroll along the River Sèvre.

Welcome to the wine estate **Poiron Dabin** in Château-Thébaud for a visit and wine tasting.

Have a stop at **Le Porte-vue** in Château-Thébaud for a panoramic view over the vineyards.

Lunch at **Auberge de la Gaillotière** in Château-Thébaud, an old winery, in the middle of the vines.

#### Afternoon

Invitation to wine estate **Château du Coing** in Saint-Fiacre-sur-Maine to visit vineyards, wine cellars and taste a range of Muscadets.

A romantic and historical walk in the **Garenne-Lemot** in Gétigné, an exceptional site heavily inspired by Italian architecture.

Contemporary cuisine from the market for dinner at the **Best** Western Villa Saint-Antoine hotel-restaurant in Clisson.

Night at the **Best Western Villa Saint-Antoine**\*\*\*\*, a 4-star hotel which offers a romantic getaway with flavors of Italy facing Clisson Medieval Castle.

## Day 2













**Guided tour of Clisson** to discover the fascinating history of the city, the impressive medieval castle, narrow streets and a range of Tuscan colors along the banks of the Sèvre Nantaise.

Visit and wine tasting at **Château Cassemichère** in La Chapelle Heulin,

Lunch at **Hall Saint-Lazare** in Le Loroux Bottereau, a gastropub in a former town hall, which has opted for discretion and finesse.

La Roche hill belvedere (Le Loroux-Bottereau): at the top of its 47 meters, in the heart of the vineyard you will enjoy a superb panoramic view over the marshes of Goulaine and Nantes.

Visit of the **Château de Goulaine** in Haute-Goulaine, a beautiful Renaissance castle on the banks of the Loire.

Typical Loire dinner Villa Mon Rêve, Basse Goulaine or Restaurant Clémence, St-Julien-de-Concelles.

Night at Maison du Monde Hôtel & suites\*\*\*\* in Nantes. It will make you feel at home right in the heart of Nantes.



## Day 1









#### Morning

Wine tasting at wine estate **Domaine des Génaudières** in Le Cellier, with a breathtaking view over the Loire.

Visit of **Oudon's medieval castle** to discover the Loire across centuries through audiovisual display. On the rooftop, one of the most beautiful views over the river!

Lunch at **La Table du Pêcheur** in Ancenis, with a waterfront terrace. Fresh fish specialities, seafood platter and Loire specialities.

#### Afternoon

Cycle ride on the **La Loire à Vélo** cycling itinerary, slowly enjoying the beauties of the royal river.

Visit of **Saint-Florent-le-Vieil**, a city of character! Its abbey-church marks the Loire landscape. A tour of the old town or a walk along the Julien Gracq promenade on the Loire banks will reveal its beauty and charm.

Dinner at restaurant **La Gabelle** in Saint-Florent-le-Vieil, its panoramic view over the Loire offers a spectacular sunset when night falls. It perpetuates the region's gourmet tradition and offers dishes prepared with flavoursome, locally-sourced produce.

Night at **Hostellerie de La Gabelle**\*\*\* in Saint-Florent-le-Vieil. The hotel boasts a peaceful setting on the banks of the Loire River.











#### Morning

Visit and wine tasting at **Domaine des Galloires** in Drain, with an exceptional view on the Loire. Here, Malvoisie, an aromatic white wine produced from Pinot Gris grapes, is an institution.

Lunch at **La Citadelle** restaurant in Champtoceaux. It offers traditional French cuisine in a setting made with stone and wooden beams.

#### Afternoon

Cruise on the Loire with **La Luce**. The tour introduces passengers to the river's wildlife, and also to the buildings along its banks. Along the way, passengers can enjoy some magnificent views, including fishing villages and a monumental garden built on a rocky outcrop.

Dinner at **Restaurant Clémence**, a gourmet restaurant on the banks of the Loire in Saint-Julien-de-Concelles. Regional and creative cuisine using fresh local products. The spirit of Clémence, mother of the famous "beurre blanc" sauce, still reigns over the restaurant.

Night at **Radisson Blu Hotel**\*\*\*\* in Nantes, Housed in a beautifully renovated neoclassical courthouse, the Radisson Blu Hotel in Nantes is ideally located for exploring the city.

## **HILLS AND CASTLES**

The Coteaux du Layon hills and castles wine route starts in Angers, where you can visit the city, the castle and its famous medieval tapestry, and last but not least the Anjou-Saumur Wine House. Along this itinerary, pretty villages follow one another: Savennières, Béhuard or La Possonnière,... This trail is also an opportunity to discover local restaurants and taste the Anjou pork rillauds specialty, with a glass of Savennières. After that, stop at Rablay-sur-Layon to admire the work of craftsmen, or take the time to visit the highest castle in France: the Château de Brissac, still home to the Brissac Family.

## Day 1









After a stroll in Savennieres, a "little city of character", enjoy a wine tasting session at **Domaine du Closel**. Discover famous dry white, red, rosé and sparkling wines and feel under your feet the slopes of slate hillsides warmed by the sun of Anjou.

Discover Béhuard, an island village that is a delight to explore! This little village is also a pilgrimage site.

Lunch at **La Corniche**, in St-Aubin-de-Luigné. The restaurant proposes a market cuisine made with fresh local produce.

#### Afternoon

Views on Ardenay's windmill, Corniche Angevine and Guerin mill and panoramas on vineyards.

Wine tasting at the wine estate **Domaine FL** in Rochefort-sur-Loire. One vineyard, five appellations: it celebrates Anjou, crafting exceptional wines of finesse, purity, elegance, and substance.

Dinner at **La Table de la Bergerie** (1 Michelin Star) in Champ-sur-Layon. The cuisine is refined, authentic and contemporary. The menu changes with the seasons and gives pride of place to the work of local producers. The estate is located in the heart of the Coteaux du Layon wine region.

Night at the **Domaine de la Soucherie**, in Rochefort-sur-Loire. Beautiful views of the vineyards from each guest room. Roger and Pascale Beguinot designed this house to make it an ideal place to

### Day 2









#### Morning

Discover charming winegrowers' villages on the wine route: Aubigné-sur-Layon, Rablay-sur-Layon and Thouarcé.

Wine tasting at the wine estate **Château de Fesles** in Thouarcé. The winegrowers will be delighted to let you explore the vineyards around the property and the splendid barrel cellar where their prestigious cuvées are aged.

Lunch at **Les terrasses de Bonnezeaux** in Thouarcé, a gourmet bistro serving traditional cuisine in the middle of the vineyards.

#### Afternoon

Visit the **Château de Brissac**: the tallest château in France. With its 7 floors and 204 rooms, Brissac deserves its nickname of "Giant of the Loire Valley".

Discover the Loire Valley wines diversity in the Caves de la Loire, in Brissac Loire Aubance.

Dinner at **Les 3 lieux** in Les Ponts-de-Cé, with a fabulous view on the Loire, either inside or on the terrace. The chef and his team prepare traditional meals with fresh seasonal produce for all kinds of appetites, big or small.

Night at Les 3 lieux\*\*\*, tucked away on the banks of the Loire, this former fishing hook factory, steeped in local heritage, has been transformed into a unique friendly and intrepid venue incorporating a hotel, a restaurant and a bistro.



### Day 1











#### Morning

Visit the Château de Saumur, the castle of Dukes of Anjou.

It stands at the edge of an abrupt cliff and boasts prime views of the city and the Loire Valley.

Visit the renowned **Ackerman cellars** – the pioneer of Loire Valley fine sparkling wines. Uncover the secrets of the méthode traditionnelle. Plunge into the heart of unique and monumental tuffa stone cellars. Travel through exhibitions by passionate artists.

Lunch at **La Cave aux Moines-Les pieds bleus** restaurant in Chênehutte. Taste local specialties inside an amazing troglodyte cave.

#### Afternoon

The cave dwelling village museum of **Rochemenier** invites you to discover an underground world: two ancient troglodytic farms with their rooms and dependencies. A unique underground lifestyle in the Loire valley!

Wine tasting at the wine estate **Domaine de la Paleine**, in Le Puy-Notre-Dame. Production of more than 100,000 bottles of red, white, rosé or sparkling organic wines.

Dinner at **L'auberge Bienvenue** in Doué-la-Fontaine. Reputed as one of the best tables in the region, the Auberge Bienvenue proposes regional dishes with fresh local produce.

Night at **L'auberge Bienvenue\*\*\***. Quality and comfort amenities... Large bright extremely comfortable rooms. Each room has been individually thought out and well decorated with pleasant soft tones.

#### Morning

Visit the **Château de Brezé**, considered as one of the most intriguing castles of the Loire, partly due to its underground fortress. Discovering the castle's history will allow you to understand the bond some of the Kings of France had with it.

Step down into the **Robert & Marcel cellars** in Saint-Cyr-en-Bourg for an amazing experience: inside the underground galleries 8 true-to-life sets relate the history of the Saumur winegrowers and all the secrets of the winemaking process from the soil to the glass. Visit followed by a wine tasting.

Lunch at **Diane de Méridor**, in Montsoreau. Located on the banks of the Loire River just a few meters from the Château de Montsoreau, the restaurant proposes a regional cuisine made with fresh quality products.

#### Afternoon

Visit Turquant, a small and pleasant village that is literally built into the hillside of tufa stone.

Welcome to the **royal abbey of Fontevraud**, the largest abbey in Europe. It is one of the unmissable stops on a visit to the Loire Valley. A stop, but also a destination... an essentially unique site!

Dinner at **Le Plantagenet** in Fontevraud. Contemporary and bistro cuisine combined with classic French dishes served in a refurbished restaurant.

A stay at the heart of Fontevraud Royal Abbey? **Fontevraud L'Hôtel** offers an incomparable experience. Sleeping in the tranquillity of the abbey, walking alone through the monastery as night falls... A peaceful time for unwinding.



In the Loir Valley, south-facing vineyards produce the best from their grape varieties. Coteaux du Loir and Jasnières reveal remarkable talents, with a palette ranging from white to red via 'gris' (grey) and rosé. Far from the bustle of cities, the Loir Valley is a land of picturesque villages of vineyards and orchards, troglodytic dwellings dug in tuffeau rock. It is a quiet paradise which you can discover by bike on the 320km Loir Valley by bicycle itinerary.



### Day 1











#### Morning

Electric bicycles rental at the tourist office in La Chartre-sur-le-Loir, to effortlessly enjoy the beautiful landscapes.

**Bicycle ride on the wine route,** crossing vineyards landscape and little villages such as Lhomme.

Typically French picnic with **Le Bon Picnic** in the countryside and among the vines.

#### Afternoon

Wine tasting and visit of cave dwellings at the wine estate **Domaine Lelais**, located in Ruillé-sur-Loir on the banks of the Loir River. The 5th generation of this winegrowers family settled down in Ruillé in 1984. Their Jasnières and Coteaux du Loir are worth a stop!

A few kilometers away, visit the **Château de Poncé and its park**. Admire the Renaissance staircase, the large 18th century dovecote and the remarkable listed garden.

Dinner at **Le Relais de Ronsard** in La Chartre-sur-le Loir. Fine dining and fine wines or brasserie bites and chilled drinks. The Hotel de France is a foodie paradise!

Night at the **Hotel de France\*\*\***. This independently-owned boutique hotel has a unique and rich motoring heritage, with racing drivers, celebrities, politicians and socialites escaping here throughout the 1950s and '60s.

ON THE ATLANTIC COAST

The first step of this circuit is the charming village of Brem-sur-Mer, on the Vendée Atlantic coast, with its listed Saint-Nicolas Church. From there, drive to the old fishing village La Gachère. What a better place to taste the local oysters, accompanied by a glass or two of Fiefs vendéens white wine. In the summer, don't forget your swimsuit to enjoy the waves of the Atlantic Ocean on the sandy beaches of Bretignolles-sur-Mer. Sea, wine and sun are on the agenda!

#### **Morning**

Stroll around Brem-sur-Mer to discover the charming village and its listed Saint-Nicolas Church. Continue to the old fishing village of "La Gachère" and taste oysters with white wine. Enjoy Vendée

On Thursday and Sunday, visit the delightful market in Brétignollessur-Mer: fresh fruit and vegetables from local producers, fish and seafood... A unique gourmet experience!

Move along the "Côte de Lumière" and take in views over the long stretches of sandy beaches.

Lunch at **La Chaize Gourmande** in La Chaize Giraud, in a retro atmosphere. The chef proposes menus and some daily suggestions, based on fresh products rigorously selected.

#### Afternoon

**Discover the marshlands** at your own pace by horse, stand-up paddle or **kayak**. Enjoy the peace and quiet of this nature reserve.

Tour and wine tasting at the wine estate **Domaine Saint-Nicolas**. The winegrowers provide high quality wines and run the vineyard according to the principles of biodynamics, thus respecting the balanced and privileged environment.

Exceptional dinner at **Les Brisants** (1 Michelin star) in Bretignollessur-Mer, in front of the sea. Depending on what the market and tides bring him, this local chef allows you to discover the fine produce from his region, combining a strong culinary heritage and a creative mind that never sleeps.

Night at **Les Brisants\*\*\***. Contemporary and cosy decor, harmonious colours, high-quality service. The rooms and suites ensure you the most pleasant stay bathed by the light of the Vendée


