

The Multi Forfait pass

This pass allows unlimited travel for one day (€30) or two days (€45) on all TER trains in Atlantic Loire Valley. From the Alpes Mancelles to the beaches of the Vendée, from the Saumurois to the Guérande peninsula, the Atlantic Loire Valley will reveal all its secrets to visitors who choose to discover it at their own pace by train.

Take the train La Loire à Vélo

This free service is designed to make it easier for cycle tourists to navigate the 800 km of marked and secure La Loire à Vélo cycling routes. Running from Saint-Nazaire to Orléans, the Interloire trains can accommodate between 9 and 33 bicycles throughout the year. During the summer season, a dedicated boarding service increases the capacity to 83 two-wheeled vehicles. Booking is highly recommended.

DAY 1

Visit the port de la Guittière in Talmont-Saint-Hilaire

A salt producing village until the beginning of 20th century, the port de la Guittière became a paradise for oyster farmers from the 1920s. This site between land and sea, bathed in the fresh, salt waters of the Payré estuary, has perfect conditions for farming oysters, with all the quality nutrients they need found there. Today, 17 oyster farmers produce oysters labelled "Vendée Atlantique". Visitors can try what they produce in their small huts lined up along this unusual port. 1 www.vendee-tourisme.com

Dinner and a night's stay at Domaine

des Clavères

With its restaurant serving delicious food focused on bistronomy, and sumptuous rooms and suites, this idyllic place gives you the opportunity to enjoy a invigorating break where you can recharge your batteries. The Domaine des Clayères opened in October 2024,

and its 4-star hotel decorated in local colours, is a new haven of peace where you can unpack your suitcase for one or more nights. It is also the perfect starting point to discover the Pointe de Payré tip and port de la Guittière, affectionately nicknamed the little Cap Ferret of Vendée! 2

DAY 2

A walk around Pointe du Payré and its forest of holm oaks

Classified part of the Natura 2000 network, this remarkable natural site is a must-see place to explore in the south of the Vendée. Facing Veillon beach and its dune that provides natural shelter for the estuary, Pointe du Payré gives you a beautiful vista, with

breathtaking views of this strip of dunes between cliffs and holm oak forest. 3

Angers and its famous museums

The capital of Anjou and the city of King René, known for its easy living, opens the doors to its two most famous museums. The David d'Angers Gallery, in a haven of light in the former Toussaint Abbey, is now home to the works of the sculptor. 

Immersion in La Cité du Lait

La Cité du Lait is both a centre for interpretation, a collection space and a place for educational activities. It is a unique site entirely dedicated to milk and its history. Thanks to a scenographic visit route featuring more than 4,000 pieces and numerous multimedia activities, visitors are invited to enjoy a delicious cultural experience at the heart of the dairy tradition, which is closely linked to the city. Discovering the Ferme du Theil cider works

In Andouillé, not far from Laval, the Ferme du Theil spreads its 34 hectares of orchards over the heart of the wooded countryside in Mayenne. Brothers Olivier and Denis Rouland are the third generation to manage this cider farm. Apple juice, cider, perry and Pommeau de Maine are produced at the farm and certified IGP (Protected Geographical Indication) and HVE (High Environmental Value). The public can enjoy a tour and tasting all year round, and discover the unusual world here! At the end of the journey, head to the farm shop, which is full of tasty artisan products. 4

Journey into nature

The Atlantic Loire Valley lies between land and sea, meaning that anyone coming to explore it will find a wide variety of landscapes there.

Boasting its coastline with two islands, regional parks, rivers that can be sailed down, and 3,400 km of marked cycle routes, the region has everything that nature lovers will love, giving them many opportunities to explore it. On foot, riding a horse, cycling or on the water: the green vistas and hidden treasures are revealed to visitors looking to escape. Whether alone, with your family or friends, the Atlantic Loire Valley is the perfect destination for recharging your batteries as close as possible to the fauna and flora.



Brière Regional Nature Park - 44 Discovering the village of Kerhinet and a ride on a barge

The second largest marsh in France, after that of the Camargue, La Brière is an exceptional protected natural reserve, currently being labelled by UNESCO. Over 3,350 plant and animal species have been identified in these 50,000 hectares of wetlands. There's nothing like a ride on a barge through the canals to see them. This traditional flat-bottomed boat means you can go anywhere through the marsh. A stop-off in a traditional Briéron village makes the tour even better. That of Kerhinet, with its 18 traditional thatched houses, is certainly the most typical!

The Maison Langlois in Saumur - 49

Tour of the vineyard in a horsedrawn carriage

What could be more romantic and bucolic than visiting this prestigious vineyard in the Val de Loire by horse-drawn carriage? A ride to the gentle pace of horses, through the vineyards and hillsides, allows you to fully immerse yourself in this pretty setting and learn more about the particularities of organic viticulture. After this break for a change of scene in the heart of nature, there is time for a tasting, during which the mysteries of how the famous Crémant de Loire is made will be partly revealed, because the House keeps its secrets.

Parigné Cheval Aventures - 72 Treks on horseback



The Atlantic Loire Valley region, Cycling country, but that's not all

Nothing beats a cycling tour for exploring a region gently and at your own pace. The Atlantic Loire Valley, criss-crossed by 6 major cycle routes (La Loire à Vélo, La Vélodyssée®, La Vélo Francette®, La Vélobuissonnière®, La Régalante et La Vélidéale), offers more than 3,400 km of landscaped and signposted cycle routes, suitable for beginners and experienced cyclists. From north to south or east to west, along the coastline or through the vineyards, the region is an ideal playground for travelling differently and enjoying the great outdoors. More than 710 establishments with the Accueil Vélo label are ready to welcome you during vour stay.

The 20th anniversary of La Loire à Vélo



In 2025, La Loire à Vélo is celebrating its 20^{th} anniversary.

The Loire à Vélo is a section of the EuroVelo6 that connects the Black Sea to the Atlantic, covering almost 4,700 km. This 900 km marked route, along the Loire in the Centre-Val de Loire and Atlantic Loire Valley regions, welcomed 1.8 million cyclists in 2022. Almost 806,000 cyclists take the 373 km of routes in the Atlantic Loire Valley each year.

It is easy to ride along, especially for families, or for a first experience cycling, and follows the course of the river. On the route, you use different types of safe and signposted lanes.

With family or friends, on a hike or a simple walk, La Loire à Vélo provides a range of services so you can organise your trip in the best possible way: accommodation located less than 5 km from the route, bicycle hire and repair, luggage transfer and bicycle transport, organised parking areas, packages for light travel or hiring a bicycle in one city and dropping it off in another, and so on.

Its route attracts many travellers every year, dazzled by the landscapes along this majestic cycle route. At every partner tourist office, cycle tourists can have their La Loire à Vélo passport stamped with a unique seal to certify their passage and keep a paper souvenir of their two-wheeled journey.

The Loire à Vélo also connects up to several cycle routes. In the Atlantic Loire Valley, it is connected to 5 véloroutes and several loop networks.



The Vélo Francette® A journey through the sweet France

The Vélo Francette® provides a route of more than 644 km connecting Ouistreham to La Rochelle, crossing three regions: Normandy, Atlantic Loire Valley and Nouvelle-Aquitaine. It takes an old railway track for 20 km and then follows the river along the towpath from Mayenne to Daon (85 km). This safe, easy route provides services adapted to cyclists in a preserved environment. La Vélo Francette® will be celebrating its 10th anniversary in 2025.

The Vélobuissonnière® An escape in nature

With 250 km of cycle routes on quiet roads and greenways, the Vélobuissonnière® connects Alençon to Saumur via Le Mans. This véloroute off the beaten track runs through the small valleys of the Alpes Mancelles, along the intimate riverbanks of the Sarthe or Loir and through the quaint, character-filled villages of the Loire Valley before reaching Saumur with its majestic castle. The landscape of this itinerary attracts cyclists, particularly the Mancelles Alps with their thousand-year-old stones and mountainous scenery, labelled as an UNESCO World Geopark in 2024.

The Régalante is a 275 km cycling getaway between Normandy, Brittany and Atlantic Loire Valley, from Mont-Saint-Michel to Nantes. One journey that can be divided into nine steps to take the time to travel through history, to marvel and to feast. The Régalante is a relatively flat route with little relief, ideal for a first family touring adventure. This cycle route is dotted with points of interest and picturesque towns including Châteaubriant and its magnificent old manor houses.
